

Guided Canoe/Kayak Weekend

Sept. 14-16, 2018



If you missed this one last year we are going to do it again this year. Members and guests join us for a fun filled “guided” weekend of canoeing and kayaking on Stillwater Reservoir. We know you like to canoe and/or kayak, but have you been as far as Beaver River without a motor? Here’s your chance, come join us and have your canoe/kayak transported to the Beaver River end of the reservoir via the bus service down nine-mile road. We will spend the whole day exploring the Stillwater Reservoir waterways, Adirondack flora and fauna, fishing, picnicking, and hiking areas you don’t normally get too. Our guide will be there to more fully help you to see what nature has to offer.

The adventure starts on Friday evening with a fall harvest dinner of local produce and farm products. A warm evening campfire follows at dusk to gets us into the Adirondack/Stillwater spirit and provide us with some local folklore by Stillwater’s famous longtime residents. Saturday morning enjoy a hardy breakfast followed by a presentation of canoeing and kayaking safety tips, plus a review of some of those special strokes that will speed us along on the day’s journey. Once we and our boats are loaded and transported down the Reservoir we will embark on our journey exploring Beaver River with time out of are boats for a hike. Bring a pole for some fishing along the way if you’d like. And we’ll have a hardy picnic lunch prepared by Rap-Shaw’s Chef while we take in the scenery. At the end of the afternoon we will be transported leisurely back to the Rap-Shaw Club, for another of those famous “BYO” Happy Hours on the porch of Main Camp. Saturday night’s dinner will be followed by a campfire and conversation. Sunday will give us time to paddle off to the dam and climb Bald or Stillwater Mountain, or stay at Rap-Shaw and try out some other form of a non-motorized vessel (row boat, rowing shell, or stand-up paddle board).

Fee: The “Canoe/Kayak Weekend” program fee (for transportation, speakers, and possibly a musician) is \$40 in addition to the standard room and board fees. Children under 12 are \$20. See the Rap-Shaw website for the 2018 Member and guest daily fees. Reservations should be made early, as space is limited. Deadline to register is August 1st .
